Character: Elegant full-bodied red wine

Grapes: Syrah 30%, Merlot 30%, Braucoil 15%, Duras 25%

Vintage: 2016

Alc: 14%

Garde: Pleasant today, can stay in the cellar for 15 years and over

Soil Type: Clay-limestone

Winemaking process: Traditional vinification methods following harvesting and destemming. Each parcel of the vineyard is vinified separately, majoritory manual harvest

Appearance: Garnet and ruby color

Aroma: Develops a very pleasant nose of dark fruits (cherry, blackcurrant) with direscreeet but present notes of licorice and cinnamon

Palate: The palate is balanced, revealing fine tannins and a good structure, a charming and elegant wine.

Pairing: Grilled meat or vegetables
