

# DOMAINE DE LA PETITE TUILE

## LE VALLON

### GAILLAC - SOUTH WEST



Character: Bold and aromatic

Grapes: 50 % Braucon, 50 % Duras

Vintage: 2017

Alc: 13,5%

Garde: 7 to 10 years

Soil Type: Clayey-limestone hillsides facing South and South-West. Enhancement natural and sowing of selected varieties alternating every row.

Winemaking process: Complete vinification in 500 L barrels (French oak). Regular punching of the cap during fermentation, handling minimum during maceration (1 month). Racking and maturing during 12 months in the same containers.

Appearance: Garnet colour

Aroma: Red and black berries with delicate spices, particularly sour cherry and cocoa

Palate: Velvety, intense and persistent, with a pleasant mouth

Pairing: Can be paired with grilled vegetables and/or red meat. Perfectly suits a winter meal.
